Hereinafter all together referred to as "Cooperation Partners", expresses their common commitment to implement the project "ONE BELT ONE ROUTE - BALTIC SILK ROUTE" in partnership in accordance with the detailed schedule of activities and budget breakdown as set in the annex of the agreement.

Article 2 Working languages

The working language is English, as agreed by the cooperation project partners

Article 3 General clauses relating to entry into force, duration, closure and place of implementation

The agreement entries in force after the approval by the General Assembly or Board of the partner LAGs, and notification there of by at least two Managing Authorities (MAs) or other national/regional authorities responsible for TNC project approval relevant to the territories in which the cooperation partners operate.

The duration of the project is, from 1st of August 2017 up to 31st of March 2019.

The locations/territories of the project activities are: Finland, Estonia, Poland and China.

Article 4 Obligations, responsibilities, liability

Partners hereby state, verify and approve the information contained in the Annex according to the project activity schedule and budget breakdown

- The Lead partner of the project is the LAG Karhuseutu (Finland) implementing partner: PRIZZTECH. The obligations and responsibilities of the lead/coordinating partner is to coordinate of joint actions within the project, development of monitoring indicators, monitoring procedures, evaluation and follow-up activities, continuous communication and liaising with project partners, reporting and support project by the Chinese presents according to the seminars.
- The obligations and responsibilities of the cooperating partners: to fulfill the commonly agreed project activity schedule and objectives of the project which partners are responsible for, ensure the funding for their share of the budget of the project and joint and local actions; to report to the project partners and lead/coordinating partner, communicate and liaising with project partners and the lead/coordinating partner, joint development of monitoring indicators, monitoring procedures and evaluation according to national rules.
- Limited liability of any cooperation partner in case of force majeure: In case of force majeure the project results achieved so far will be reported to General Meeting/Board of LAGs and MAs
- Limited liability of other project partners due to any damages and costs resulting from the non-compliance of any of the cooperation partners. Other partners are non liabel to the damages and costs resulting from the non-compliance of any of the cooperation partners.

Article 5 Changes in the partnership

 Changes in the partnership are done by written amendment agreed and signed by all of the cooperation partners in cases of extending the partnership: new cooperation partner(s) enter(s);

- or one (or more) cooperation partner(s) leave(s) the partnership.
- In case of the need to modify the budget by one or more partners, the modification should not have affect the overall aim of the project. In case extending the partnership the budget will increase according to the budget of new entering partner. In case of any of the partners leaves the partnership the common budget will be decreased accordingly.
- Partners are obliged to notify relevant authorities of the changes in the project in due course.
- Changes of the agreed issues should be done in the steering group. It can be in the meetings or submitted via mail to all partners and accepted by email confirmation.

Article 6

Project management

- Partners communicate between each other via electronic communication tools like email, skype etc.
- Project management committee (steering committee) will consist of legal representatives from each participating LAGs and implementing partners. At least two nominated persons from each partners.
- Secretariat of the project management committee will be provided from the hosting partner.
- At least once a year meetings will be carried out during common events.
- Partners are responsible to inform the other partners about obstacles to the implementation of the tasks, including the risk of exceeding the agreed deadline for task completion.
- The leading partner is responsible for collection and archiving of collaborative documentation
 of the whole project according to monitoring and evaluation rules. If some partners need some
 extra documentation it's in their own responsibility. Partners are responsible for collection and
 archieving of documentation of their project activities according to monitoring and evaluation
 rules in applying country.

Article 7 Dispute resolution, applicable law

- First and preferred means of dispute resolution will be done by amicable settlement.
- In case of failure of amicable agreement, the applicable jurisdiction is of the MS/region of the lead/coordinating partner i.e Finland.
- For purposes of dispute resolution at court the English version of the text of this agreement and its annexes is applicable.

Article 8 Amendment of the agreement

- Only by written amendment agreed and signed by all of the cooperation partners are valid
- Any amendments to the agreement to be communicated to the relevant authorities in due course.

This agreement has been finalised in Pori, Finland.

1.1 Description of the general and specific objectives of the project

- Tourism Package: create tourism packages with partners for the market in third countries (incl China). Package can be bus tour Finland - Estonia - Poland. Feedback from Chinese groups;
 Organising small test trip - by the partnership - seminars in Partners' countries separately country by country
- to elaborate a study program for Chinese partners on rural tourism
